Mr. Vesa Vasara is the Ambassador of Finland to Estonia since September 2022.

Ambassador Vesa Vasara arrived to Tallinn from London where he served as Deputy Head of Mission. From 2017 to 2021, Ambassador Vasara served as Finland's Ambassador to Denmark. Mr. Vasara served in Tallinn from 2009 to 2012 as Minister Counsellor (DHOM). Mr. Vasara has also worked previously at Finland's Embassies in Berlin and Moscow, as well as in the Permanent Mission of Finland to the OSCE.

Ambassador Vasara joined the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in 1995. He has served, among other positions, as Director of the Unit for Northern Europe and Deputy Director General in the Department of Russia, Eastern Europe and Central Asia.

Mr. Vesa Vasara was born in Helsinki in 1963. He graduated in 1991 with a Master's degree in History from the University of Helsinki. He speaks Swedish, English, German and Estonian.
