Anna-Kaisa Heikkinen has been working as Finland’s Ambassador to Mozambique, Eswatini and Madagascar since September 2020. Before moving to Maputo, she worked as Finland’s Ambassador to Palestine in 2017–2020. Prior to that, Ms. Heikkinen worked in the Prime Minister’s Office as the diplomatic advisor to Finland’s Prime Minister in 2014-2017.

In the Ministry for Foreign Affairs, Ms. Heikkinen has earlier worked, among others, as the deputy head of the Unit for Russia, as well as the editor of the Ministry’s trade policy magazine Kauppapolitiikka. Her earlier foreign postings include New Delhi, Moscow and Petrozavodsk. She joined the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in 2003. Prior to that, she worked in the field of communications.

Ambassador Heikkinen holds a M. Soc. Sc. degree in international relations from the University of Tampere in Finland. Besides her native Finnish, she works in English, Swedish, German, Russian, Portuguese, Hindi, French and Arabic. Ambassador Heikkinen has authored a textbook of Hindi for Finnish-speaking students.
