Marjaana Sall serves as Finnish Ambassador to Morocco and Mauritania since September 1, 2023. Prior to her current position, she served four years as Ambassador for Education at the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland.

Marjaana Sall has extensive experience in Africa having held 12 years diplomatic positions in Africa. Before taking up the position of Ambassador for Education, she served as the European Union Ambassador to the Republic of Mauritius and to the Republic of Seychelles. She was the first Finnish female EU Ambassador appointed by the Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy in 2015.

She has also worked as Deputy Ambassador of the European Union to Kenya and as Deputy Ambassador of the Finnish Embassy to South Africa and to Indonesia. She has also held a position at the Permanent Mission of Finland to the United Nations in New York and various positions at the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in Helsinki.

Marjaana Sall joined the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland in 1997. She holds a Master of Laws degree From University of Helsinki and Licence Spéciale en droit Européenne from Université Libre de Bruxelles.

She is married and has three children .
