Matti Nissinen is the Ambassador of Finland to Kosovo since September 2022.

Before his current position, Ambassador Nissinen worked at the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland as Director for European Common Foreign and Security Policy.

He has also served as Diplomatic Adviser to the Minister for Foreign Affairs. At the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in Helsinki, Mr. Nissinen has held several positions related to European Union affairs. During his career, he has worked at Political Department, Department for Europe, Department for the Americas and Asia, and Department for Communications.

Ambassador Nissinen has served at the Permanent Representation of Finland to the EU in Brussels, Embassy of Finland in Ljubljana, and Permanent Mission of Finland in Geneva.

He holds a Master's Degree in Political Science.

Ambassador Nissinen speaks Finnish, Swedish, English and German. He joined the Foreign Ministry as a career diplomat in 2005.
