Consular Letter – Entry in Finland with full vaccination against COVID-19

The Consulate of Finland in São Paulo hereby confirms that in line with the Government decision of Monday July 15th 2021, **persons who are able to present a certificate of a completed and approved COVID-19 vaccination can arrive in Finland from all countries starting on Monday July 26th 2021.**

People travelling to Finland must take into account that a certificate of recovery from COVID-19 is an acceptable justification for entry into the country only for citizens of the EU and Schengen countries and for people residing in an EU or Schengen country.

In addition, from July 26th onwards, cruise ship passengers arriving from an EU or Schengen country are allowed to disembark.

Approved vaccines include those that are listed as approved by the European Medicines Agency (EMA), the United States Food and Drugs Administration (FDA), the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) in the UK, and the World Health Organisation (WHO). A certificate produced in connection with entry must include the name and date of birth of the person who has been vaccinated or had Covid-19 infection, the vaccine that was given, the date of each dose received in the vaccine series, where and when the vaccination took place, and the signature and seal, or equivalent confirmation of who issued the certificate. **The presented certificate must be in Finnish, Swedish or English.**
